1.	Displaying, selling, transporting, or collecting of animals, plants, ores, and their specimens or derived products which are illegally hunted or collected.	3000	3000	3000
2.	Bringing shotguns, cables, nets, clips, cages, batteries, poison, and other hunting equipment capable of capturing, hunting, harming, or poisoning wildlife into the National Park.	3000	3000	3000
3.	Peddling, erecting stalls, or engaging in performance activities without permission or authorization.	3000	3000	3000
4.	Earth filling, land leveling, or dumping soil and rocks.	3000	3000	3000
5.	Establishing votive offering facilities or graves, posting advertisements or mobile advertisements, hanging or placing trail markings, or establishing other facilities that disturb the landscape.	1500	3000	3000
6.	Creating a disturbance, lighting campfires, cooking, barbecuing, grass boarding, swimming, river tracing, rock climbing, camping, erecting	1500	3000	3000

7.	Littering plastic bottles, polystyrene, other plastic or metal products, food waste, and other objects and trash not compostable or biodegradable.	1500	3000	3000
8.	Lighting firecrackers, fireworks, joss paper, and other objects which could disturb public safety.	1500	3000	3000
9.	Parking carelessly and disrupting traffic within the National Park.	600	1200	2400
10.	Destructing public property and facilities.	3000	3000	3000
11.	Abandoning or releasing animals, or feeding wildlife.	3000	3000	3000
12.	Entering into areas publically prohibited from entry or entering into Zhuilu Old Road without prior permission.	1500	3000	3000
13.	Bringing pets into the Ecological Protection Area, the Historical Preservation Area, or the Special Landscape Area (with the exception of along the highway).	600	1200	2400
14.	Changing and altering authorized routes, itinerary, and campgrounds upon entering the Ecological Protection Area. Emergency evacuations are exempt from this rule.	3000	3000	3000
15.	Entering into closed trails within the National Park, or straying from routes of open trails.	1500	3000	3000
16.	Establishing memorial plaques or other monumental facilities without authorization.	1500	3000	3000
